# IMPORTANT ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

School attendance is a primary focus for Mount Vernon School District. The district's goal is a 100% graduation rate. Classes at Jefferson begin at 8:30 a.m.

## THREE WAYS TO REPORT A STUDENT'S ABSENCE:

- 1) Give the school office a signed & dated note with <u>planned</u> absence dates. Information needed on note: Student's Full Name, Teacher/Grade, Reason for Absence, Dates of Absence and Parent/Guardian Signature.
- 2) **Call the school office**, (360) 428-6128, the day of absence and send a **signed & dated note** to the office with dates of absence <u>when student returns</u>.
- 3) A parent/guardian may **email Jefferson Attendance** by going to Jefferson's website: <a href="http://www.jefferson.mountvernonschools.org">http://www.jefferson.mountvernonschools.org</a>. On the Home page of the website, scroll down to **SCHOOL LINKS** and click on *Report Student Attendance*, this will open an online absence report form.

## Please DO NOT email teachers with attendance information.

If a student's absence is not reported to the school office by 10:00 am on the day of absence an automated call will go out to parent/guardian.
